Ebbtide Pattern Notes

Shifting stitch markers

In the Sand Dollar LaceEdging, increases and decreases occur on the edges of the pattern repeats on some rows. If you have placed additional stitch markers between the pattern repeats, you will need to shift the markers as described below to keep the pattern repeats aligned to the chart.

Set up row shift: Following written instructions, *work to one st before marker, slip next st to RH needle, remove marker, sl st back to LH needle, replace marker on RH needle. Rep from * across all *full* pattern repeats.

Row 3 shift: *Work from chart to two sts before marker, slip next 2 sts together as if to knit, remove marker and complete cdd, then replace marker on RH needle. Rep from * across all *full* pattern repeats.

Rows 5 & 9 shift: *Work from chart to one st before marker, slip next st to RH needle, remove marker, sl st back to LH needle, replace marker on RH needle. Rep from * across all *full* pattern repeats.

Row 12 shift: *Work from chart to marker, remove marker, work next st, replace marker on RH needle. Rep from * across all *full* pattern repeats.
